FAMILY PREPAREDNESS

The Richmond Society for Community Living recognises it will be extremely difficult to be at work in the event of a major disaster such as an earthquake. We have included this section hoping you will take initiative and plan well for you and your family.

Emergency Preparedness Professionals advise no one travel on the roads unless absolutely necessary. It is also imperative that RSCL staff remain with the individuals/children they are supporting, as they have no other means of supporting themselves.

Please familiarise yourself with the following information, make a photocopy and use the template if you wish. If you have detailed plans it will help to ease your mind until you are able to reunite with your family.
