Our services for adults with developmental disabilities offer support and assistance in the steps towards achieving greater independence.

Residential support is provided by trained staff for individuals who choose to live, with up to three others, in their own home and in their own community.

Day programs offer a variety of assistance and support in the areas of life-skills, leisure and recreation, volunteerism and job placements, with a focus on community and social inclusion.

Employment Services provide opportunities for adults with developmental disabilities to explore employment options with support and assistance in the steps towards independence in the workforce.

Family Respite provides relief for parents from the daily responsibilities and accompanying stress of caring for children or adults who have a developmental disability.

Supported Living offers a variety of individualized living options for adults. The program focuses on optimizing independence, self-determination, personal choice and growth.

Family Resources and Coordination provides information, resources and/or support to family members who face the extraordinary circumstances that come with having a family member with a disability.
